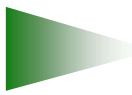

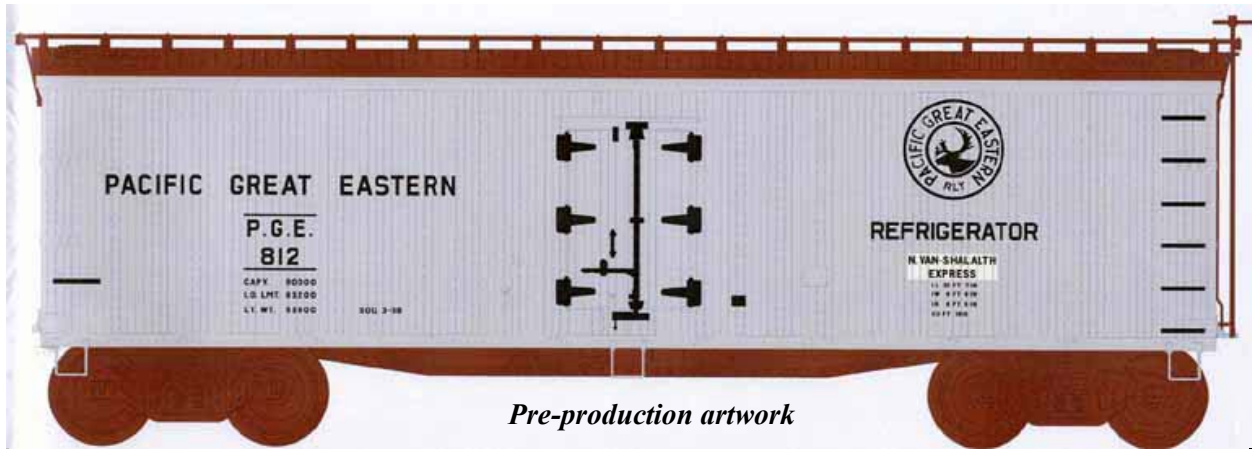

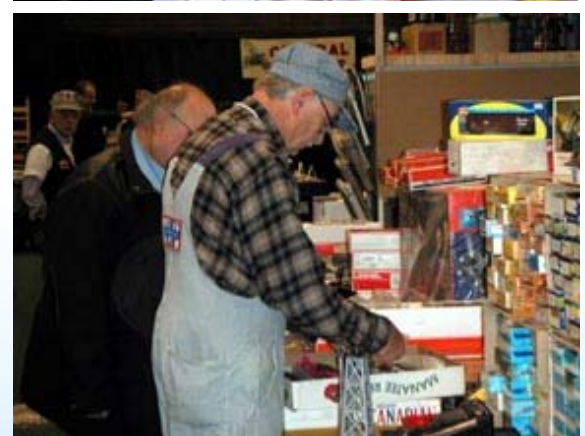


CAMERON REC CENTRE SHOW November 12 & 13

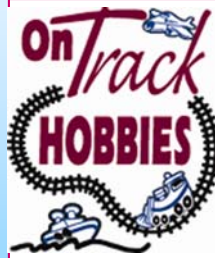

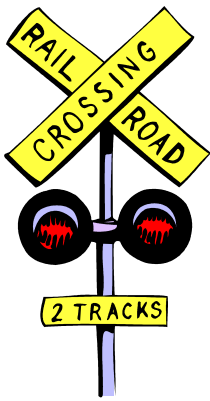
