Atlas O is making a prototypical 53' 6" Wood Express Reefer in the Canadian Pacific Railway colors. This very limited production "O" gauge reefer is comes in two numbers in both 2 and 3 rail.

Production is scheduled for the Fall with delivery during December 2010.
 Cost is \$ 70.00 CDN plus \$ 14.00 CDN shipping; for the first car and \$ 6.00 CDN shipping per additional car ordered.

The price will have to change if the Canadian dollar drops dramatically against the US dollar.
