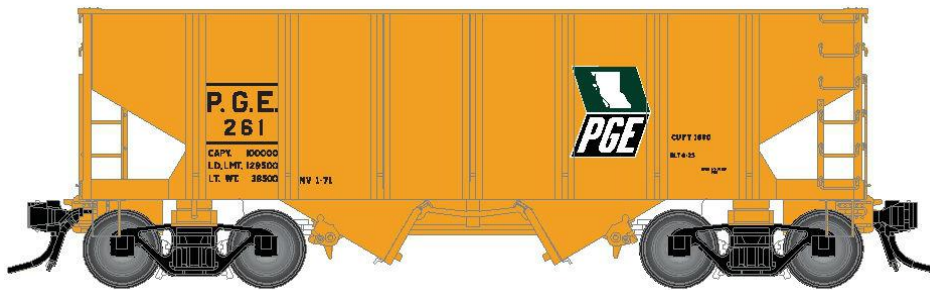


Pacific Great Eastern Atlas 55 Ton Coal Hopper
