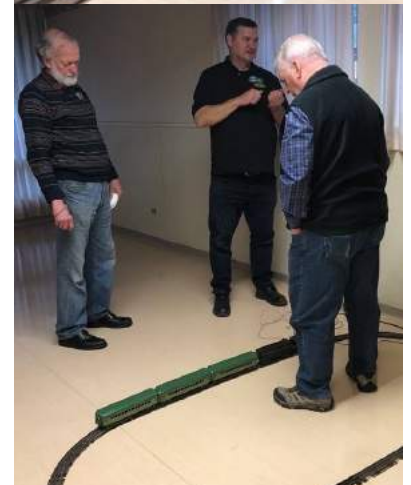

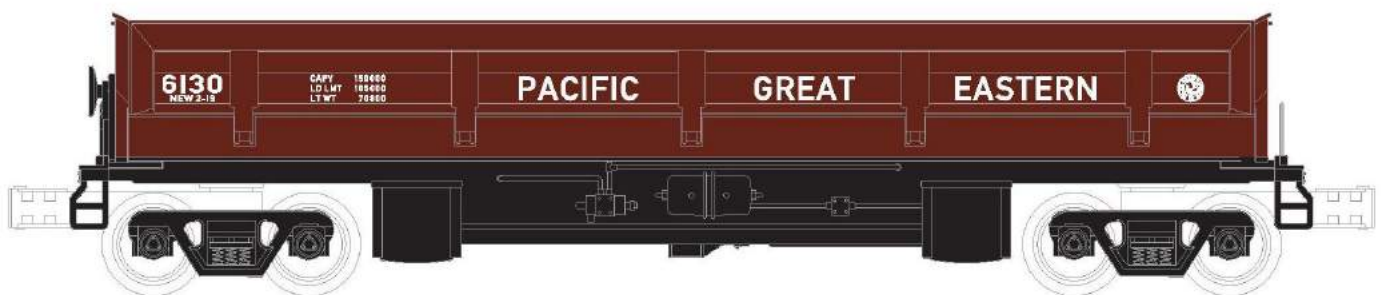

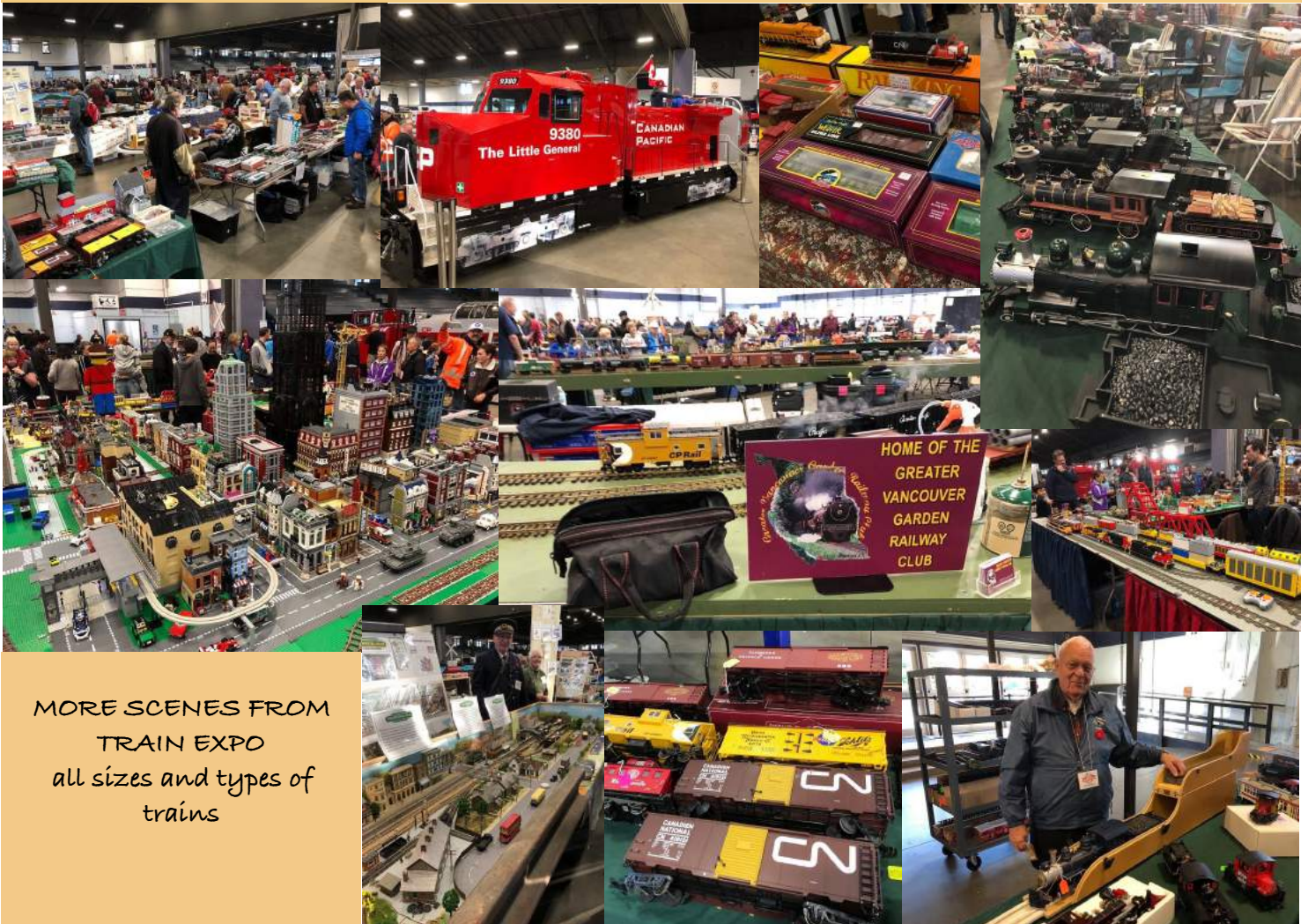

CTTA Saturday January 19, 2019 Bus Trip

The Great Train Show at Western Washington Fair Grounds

Note: This year the bus departs at 7:30am sharp. No waiting for late arrivals.

Price: \$40 for the bus, \$25 dinner. Package deal: \$65

Remember

1. If you are late for the bus, we cannot and do not wait. The bus will depart the Campbell River Store at 7:30am sharp. There are no refunds.
2. Passport
3. Buy your parking ticket for the Campbell River Store. Store opens at 7:00am, \$5.00 for the day
4. Spending Money. (\$US) Go to the Bank the day before
5. You must take everything you bring with you off the bus through US Immigration. Don't bring any fruit or meats with you

Our Itinerary

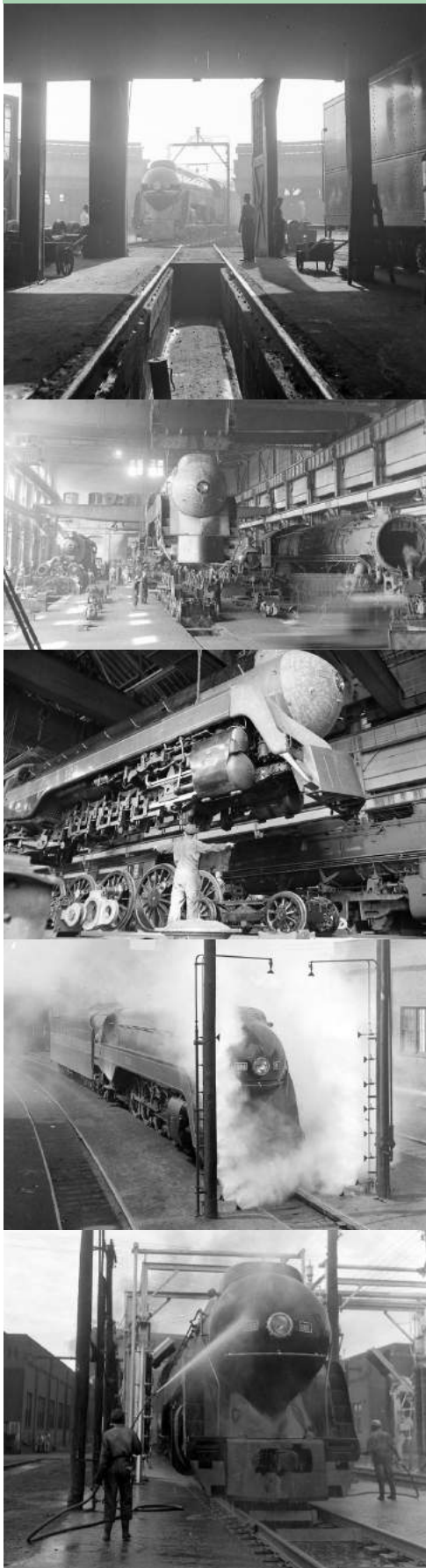
- **7:30am Bus Departs** Campbell River Store. This is later than previous years as the restrictions to bus travel dictate that we decrease our travel time. Parking is available when you purchase a ticket from the store at \$5.00 for the day.
- 9:30am: Breakfast, McDonalds on I5 in Mt. Vernon. Tickets to the show will be handed out after breakfast
- 11:00am: Arrive at the show
- **3:30pm: Bus Departs** the show. This is the departure time not the boarding time
- 5:30pm: Dinner @ Tulalip Casino Buffet (We have reservations and do not wait in line)
- **7:00pm: Bus Departs** Tulalip
- 7:45pm: Arrive border
- 8:15 pm: Campbell River store, home

Your PASSPORT is your best friend. Don't forget it. Also spending money is important. Don't forget that either. Secure your keys in a closed pocket.

It cannot be emphasized enough that we cannot be late at any time on our itinerary. We must depart on time and stick to our schedule or better it.

Regulations for bus charters get tighter every year and the fines for running late will be costly.

Tickets will be bought in advance on line at \$10.00 USD. The online ticket purchase must be done before January 9 in order to get the discount. Purchasing will be done January 8. **Please email or call James before January 8 if your plans change. (Going or not going)**
