

passed away on Sunday, April 12. I didn't know Harry well but I do know that he had one of the best jobs ever! Harry was an engineer with Hillcrest Lumber and did relief work running the logging train at The Duncan Logging Museum. We will miss him.

At the March meeting I announced that the National Executive had cancelled the 2010 convention in Canada. Reasons given were the economy and the fact that US Citizens will need a passport to reenter their country. The economy argument might get some mileage in some circles but the passport issue is to me a lame excuse. The cost of the passport seems to be an issue in the USA but a US Citizen only pays \$100. for a passport that is good for ten years. A very reasonable cost for the convenience of being able to travel.

We had obtained permission from the White Pass & Yukon RR to use their logos and produce a Woodside Boxcar for the convention. We sent a cheque for \$500. (USD) to pay Lionel for the prototypes in "O" Scale and "S" Scale. National did not sign the contract within the forty-five days allotted by Lionel. Subsequently, Lionel cancelled the terms of the contract. The new contract raised the minimum cars we had to order, raised the cost of the cars and also raised the shipping costs. Questions were asked of National about the number of cars that have been selling these past few years ... and to make a long story short, what with the poor sales of recent cars, it would have been financially impossible for the Canadian Division to reap any rewards from the efforts of producing a "Division Car". National has returned our cheque and it is a closed case.

On a happier note, The Pacific Northwest Division hosted a meet in Bellingham WA. Those who attended had a great time and to boot it was a beautiful day for the drive down and back. A thank you to **Tom Modica** for hosting a great meet.

Atlas O Canadian Northern Railway 40' Woodsided Reefer


