



Originally constructed in 1910, the Fraser Mills station was later moved to its present site in Heritage Square, at the Place des Arts.


Fraser Mills station now stands as a reminder of Maillardville's beginnings, a piece of living history in Coquitlam's French-Canadian community.


They have a great toy train collection too!
