CTTA meets 10 times a year, on the last Sunday of the month (except July & August. December meet is before Christmas) at the Charles Rummel Community Centre, 3630 Lozells Ave, Burnaby. Doors at 10:30, lunch at noon, business at 12:30 with tables sales, door prizes and an auction.

Annual Membership is \$20.00. Meeting fees are \$10.00 which covers food, beverages, rent and prizes.

Our primary focus has been the collectible O, S and Standard gauge model trains and accessories made by Lionel, American Flyer, Bing, Ives, Marx, Marklin and others before and after WW2, and now the modern 'high rail' electronic trains made by Lionel, MTH, Atlas, Weaver, and Williams today. All gauges, including HO, N and G turn up regularly at our meets. We operate 2 large modular layouts for CTTA and members equipment.
