CTTA meets 10 times a year. We meet on the last Sunday of the month (except July, August) and in December, a Sunday before Christmas, at the Charles Rummel Community Centre, 3630 Lozells Ave, Burnaby. Doors open at about 10:30, lunch at noon, business at 12:30 with tables sales, door prizes and an auction.

Annual Membership dues is \$25.00. Meeting fees are \$10.00 for food and beverages.

Our primary focus has been the collectible O, S and Standard gauge model trains and accessories made by Lionel, American Flyer, Bing, Ives, Marx, Marklin and others before and after WW2 and the modern 'high rail' electronic trains made by Lionel, MTH, Atlas, Weaver, and Williams today. All gauges, including HO, N and G turn up regularly at our meets. We operate a large modular layout for CTTA and members' equipment.
